

## **FSIN meeting in Swift Current: Looking for business opportunities**

The Federation of Saskatchewan Indian Nations is looking at ways to foster innovative entrepreneurs among its members.

One day before the fall session of the legislative assembly was scheduled to take place, the FSIN held the First Nations Investors Symposium at the Entrepreneurial Centre on Oct. 19.

Guy Lonechild, second vice-chief, said the First Nations are looking for more partners in the broader economy to create viable business opportunities within communities.

Lonechild cited the southwest beef initiative as a venture that could provide many jobs for First Nations people.

"We're looking at the values of that industry," he said. "Synergies of culture and bringing First Nations people to a safe quality of food."
