

LR Truck Centre – Tillage Village expansion in the works

A major addition is planned for L.R. Truck Centre/Tillage Village in Swift Current.

Lyndon and Val Raynard, owners of L.R. Truck Centre/Tillage Village confirmed plans to construct a 14,000 square foot addition to their current operation. The 105 by 135 foot addition will feature a state-of-the-art Truck Wash facility, an expansion of one and a half truck repair service bays, and a yet to be unveiled special project in connection with the addition.

Work is scheduled to begin in June with a projected opening date of Nov. 1. The expansion will create a minimum of five new full time positions.

Raynard said the truck wash will boast a combination of many washes he has inspected over a two year period. Through intensive research he has compiled the latest technology to best meet the needs of future customers.

He noted the expansion will include a drivers lounge, showers, laundry facilities, and PET WASH, the first of its kind for Swift Current.

The addition will be constructed along the Westside of the existing premises. They employ 17 staff and have been in business since 1981.
